

1. Files and data to be provided to the competition organiser

The Flarm device ID of the competing glider shall be provided for the tracking use. Also the IGC-file of the primary logger shall be provided to the competition organiser. These can be sent by email scoring@rayskala.fi.

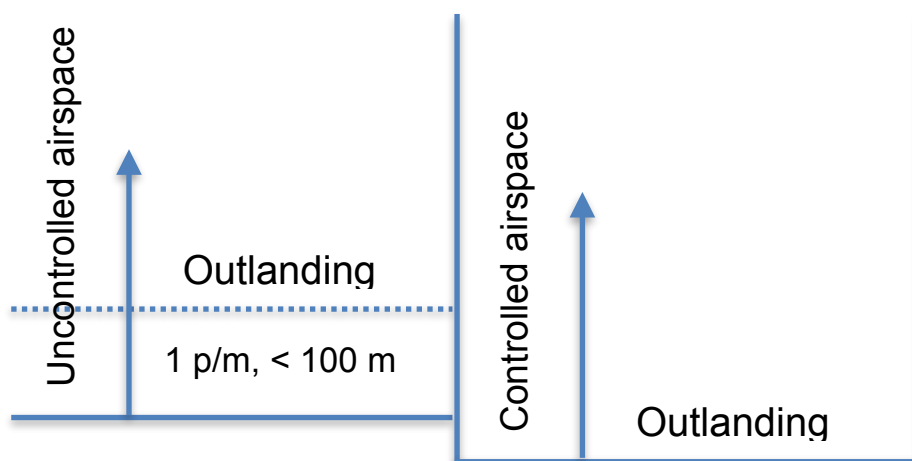
2. Competition airspace file

The competition airspace file was published on the competition web page in the Documents & Info section. The airspace file is in .cub format.

3. Upper limit of the competition airspace sector

When the upper limit of an airspace sector is limited by the uncontrolled airspace and violated, the 100 m buffer is in use and penalty rule 1 point/m is applied like shown in the figure below. If airspace upper limit violation is more than 100 m, outlanding is applied.

When the upper limit of an airspace sector is limited by controlled airspace, the outlining is applied for the violation of the airspace sector upper limit.
